

2012 SENATE VOTING RECORDS

KASB selected two significant Senate votes for the 2012 session. *(Names in parenthesis were the Senators elected to that seat in 2008).*

1. **HB 2117** was the first Senate vote on the major income tax cut eventually signed by the Governor. It failed 20-20, which is the vote listed. It was reconsidered after several Senators changed their vote to allow the measure to go to conference committee. Some Senators indicated they would not have supported the bill if given a chance to vote again on final action. **SJ 1947-48**
2. **HB 2200** was the vote to establish a Senate position on school finance. It would have provided an increase in base state aid for the next two years, increased maximum Local Option Budget authority over two years, and made both contingent on achieving full funding of LOB state aid in two years. **SJ 1949** (Funding for increased state aid was added to the Senate budget bill on a voice vote without recording individual votes.)

1. **HB 2191** allows for an additional two-year period for a teacher to earn continuing contract rights if the board and teacher agree to such an arrangement. *KASB supported.* May 5, 2010 **SJ 478**
2. **HB 2015** contains both the extension, for two years, the 20-mill statewide property tax levy and the provision that allows LOBs to be computed on a base of \$4,433 until June 30, 2014. *KASB supported.* May 5, 2010 **SJ 478**
3. **H. Sub for SB 111** allows for a district to spend unencumbered balances for general operating expenses based on a calculation using a base of \$4,012. *KASB supported.* May 12, 2011 **SJ 1305**
4. **H. Sub for SB 21** mandates KSDE establish a uniform reporting system for receipts and expenses. *KASB supported.* May 12, 2011 **SJ 1296**

2010 SENATE VOTING RECORDS

1. **HB 2631** Senate budget plan; keeps K-12 education funding at the current year's level but leaves a \$300 million deficit. *KASB was in favor of the budget plan*. May 5, 2010 **SJ 1470**
2. Masterson amendment to **HB 2595**; reduces general state aid for districts by \$80 million through a cut to school finance weighting but allows districts to raise money through local property taxes. *KASB opposed the amendment*. May 5, 2010 **SJ 1470**
3. **Senate Sub for HB 2360**; Senate budget bill enacting a 1 percent state sales tax, raising over \$300 million in the next three years to avoid deeper cuts in education. *KASB was in favor of the substitute bill*. May 6, 2010 **SJ 1536**
4. **House Sub for SB 572**; the House version of the budget bill which does not reduce education funding and relies on a tax increase. *KASB was in favor of the bill*. May 10, 2010 **SJ 1604**

2012 Kansas House of Representatives Voting Records

The 2012 House report covers eight votes: a constitutional amendment, two amendments offered during floor debate and five bills.

1. **HB 2444** turned KSDE guidelines covering seclusion and restraint into a statute. KASB opposed because it reduced local flexibility and added costs. **HJ 1909**
2. **HB 2634** addressed a number of issues covering teacher evaluation and professional development. KASB supported. **HJ 2107**
3. **HB 2718** created a Local Activities Budget, which would allow districts spending less than the per student average to raise their mill levy to provide additional funds. KASB opposed because it would not be equalized with state aid. **HJ 2175**
4. **HB 2767** amendment by Rep. Jim Ward, D-Wichita, It would have provided an increase in base state aid for the next two years, increased maximum Local Option Budget authority over two years, and made both contingent on achieving full funding of LOB state aid in two years. KASB supported. **HJ 2275**
5. **HB 2767** allowed individual to receive a 90% tax credit for donations to non--profits that give scholarships to certain students for use at private schools. KASB opposes tax funds for private schools. **HJ 2275-76**
6. **HCR 5006** attempted to restrict courts from ordering school funding. KASB opposed. As a constitutional amendment, it need two-thirds to pass, which is 84 votes. **HJ 2295-96**
7. **HB 2117** creates significant cuts in income tax revenues. KASB opposed. **HJ 2521**
8. **SB 393** was amended on the House floor by Greg Smith, R-Overland Park. It would prohibit districts from spending LOB dollars to sue the state. KASB opposed. Current law prohibits them from spending general fund dollars. **HJ 2558**

2011 Kansas House of Representatives Voting Records

The first seven votes were identified as issues addressed directly by KASB policies. All but one passed only in the **House. H. Sub for SB 1**, which passed in both chambers, was considered substantially altered after passing the House and received no further Senate attention. Though failing this year, a number of these issues, along with several constitutional amendments introduced in House Education, are likely to emerge early as key 2012 session items. Items eight through eleven passed both chambers.

1. **HB 2200** would reduce the state aid formula bond and interest payments on bonds issued by school districts for capital improvements and for capital outlay resolutions. *KASB opposed.* Feb. 24, 2011 **HJ 355**
2. **H. Sub for SB 1.** Could significantly reduce future expenditures by guaranteeing reductions in personal, corporate tax rates. *KASB opposed.* March 18, 2011 **HJ 567 583 584**

4. **HB 2269** would mandate all districts impose a minimum 10 % LOB, which would be counted as state foundational aid. *KASB opposed.* March 31, 2011 **HJ 838**
5. **HB 2251** Rescinds state aid for out-of state students. *KASB opposed.* Feb. 24, 2011 **HJ 357**
6. **HB 2006** Strips undocumented Kansas graduates of in-state tuition rates. *KASB opposed.* Feb. 22, 2011 **HJ 310**
7. **HB 2004** reduces to 2.5 from 10 miles the distance a student had to live from his or her normal building that could be transported and enrolled by another district. *KASB opposed.* Feb. 23, 2011 **HJ 329**
8. **HB 2191** Allows for an additional two-year period for a teacher to earn continuing contract rights if the board and teacher agree to such an arrangement. *KASB supported.* May 10, 2011 **HJ 1115, 1126**
9. **HB 2015** contains both the extension, for two years, the 20-mill statewide property tax levy and the provision that allows LOBs to be computed on a base of \$4,433 until June 30, 2014. *KASB supported.* May 12, 2011 **HJ 1572 1656**
10. **SB 111** allows for a district to spend unencumbered balances for general operating expenses based on a calculation using a base of \$4,012. *KASB supported.* May 5, 2011 **HJ 1572**

5. O'Neal amendment to **House Sub for SB 572**; to pursue 65 percent classroom spending. *KASB opposed the amendment*. May 7, 2010 **HJ 1760**
6. **House Sub for SB 572**; House budget that restores \$86 million to schools, restored cuts to early childhood programs and added spending for numerous other social services. *KASB was in favor of the amended bill*. May 8, 2010 **HJ 1783**
7. **Senate Sub for HB 2360**; Senate budget bill enacting a 1 percent state sales tax, raising over \$300 million in FY 11 and almost \$1 billion in the next three years to avoid deeper cuts in education. *KASB was in favor of the bill*. May 10, 2010 **HJ 1815**

2. **H Sub for SB 22** was the House leadership budget bill for FY 2010. *KASB opposed the bill.* May 1, 2009 **HJ 693**
3. **S Sub for HB 2373** Senate budget plan, which held education cuts to 2.75 percent. *KASB supported the Senate plan.* May 7, 2009 **HB 713**
4. **Sub for HB 2365** Senate plan to raise \$60 million in revenue to close the final budget gap. *KASB supported the plan.* May 8, 2009 **HJ 730**
5. **HB 2328** would have created a back-to-school sales tax holiday. *KASB opposed the bill.* March 24, 2009 **HJ 406**
6. During the debate on the Omnibus Appropriations Bill, **H Sub for SB 22**, Rep. Knox, R-Altoona, made a motion to repeal the in-state tuition status given to undocumented residents who met a prescribed set of requirements. *KASB Opposed the amendment.* May 1, 2009 **HJ 689**
7. **SB 84** passed in the waning hours of the session. It allowed for the use of \$4,433 in computing the LOB even if the amount authorized for a future year is lower.
