### **About this Workshop:**

This workshop explores key concepts related to prevention of and intervention for bullying behaviors by adults and students. The Kansas Blue Ribbon Task Force on Bullying Report (December 10, 2019) recommendations will be reviewed. Structured planning time will allow board members and staff to discuss current practices and policies and identify next steps to align district practice and policy with the Task Force recommendations and best practice.

### **Participants will:**

- Gain familiarity with the Task Force Report and resources available.
- Identify types of bullying:
  - Physical
  - Verbal (includes cyber)
  - Relationship (includes cyber)
  - Damage to property
- Recognize risk factors for perpetrators and targets, including vulnerable populations
- Discuss the effects of bullying on:
  - Perpetrators
  - Targets/victims/ survivors
  - Bystanders
- Understand effective practices and policies include both inside-out and outside-in strategies.
- Acknowledge that bullying behavior must be addressed in the context of developing a healthy, nurturing culture that meets the needs of children and adults.
